ESTIMATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT OF WATER SUPPLY

[01] To consider and approve the following estimates for Improvement of Water Supply in Secunderabad Cantonment Area.

RESOLUTION : Matter discussed at length. The CEO informed the Board that the estimates mentioned at Sl.No 1, expenditure for purchase of pipes and laying of pipes will be incurred by the colony people and from Sl.No 2 to 4 the expenditure will be incurred by the Board and at Sl. No 5, the Colony has accepted to supply the material and the civil work has to be carried out by the Cantonment Board. Considered and resolved to be approved. Further resolved to check and inspect on the ground for the requirement of any pipeline from Gun Bazar to Secunderabad. If there is any requirement a detailed estimates to be prepared and placed in the next Board meeting.

ADDITION OF WATER TANKERS

[02] To consider the matter for hiring of additional water tankers for improvement of water supply.

Cantonment Board hired water tankers for supplying water in various localities of Secunderabad Cantonment. Three (03) Cantonment Water Tankers and Six (06) hired private water tankers were being used for supplying of water to Cantonment localities. In addition to nine (09) existing water tankers five (05) more water tankers are to be hired for supplying of Drinking Water through tankers to meet the summer demand.

Therefore, the existing contractor of water tankers for supplying of drinking water may be instructed to add five more water tankers to meet the requirement.

The relevant file is placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Matter discussed at length and resolved that Five more water tankers be hired immediately to meet the demand of supply of water during the summer . Further resolved that the Superintendent water works to inspect the site on ground and to report how many water connections are legal and how many are illegal as per CBR No 28(2) dated 14-12-2010 and also to check how many bills were issued for demanding payment of water charges and how many individuals paid / cleared their dues.

LAYING OF PIPELINE TO CONNECT 6½” DIA BORE WELLS

[03] To consider the matter of laying of 32mm / 25mm / 20mm dia water pipeline for supply of bore well water.

Secunderabad Cantonment Board executed the work of drilling of 6½” dia bore wells at various localities of Cantonment Area. The work is carried out in two phases to dug 32Nos. bore wells. Out of 32 bore wells 4 bore wells were failed and the estimations are prepared to rest of 28 bore wells to connect pipeline for supplying of bore well water to nearest localities.

The details of the bore wells including submersible motor pump capacity and remarks of proposed pipe line are given below:

RESOLUTION: Matter discussed at length and resolved that at points where the new submersible bore well were created by the Board, required capacity of Sintex Water Tanks at least four points in each ward shall be installed with multiple connections to the said tank at sites, no pipe line to the distant area required to be laid to keep in the view to save energy and

also save ground water table, otherwise the citizens will be deprived of the water due to non-availability of ground water in summer.

CONSTRUCTION OF SEMI UNDER GROUND SUMPS

[4] To consider the matter for construction of Semi Under Ground Sumps at the following places of Secunderabad Cantonment for improvement of Water Supply

1. Bollarum Over Head Tank
2. Hasdmathpet Tapping Point.

RESOLUTION: The Matter discussed at length and resolved that (1). construction of underground sump near the over head tank at Bolarum and (2) construction of underground sump at neat hasmathpet tapping point, the Board agreed to put up a detailed designs and drawings along with estimates as early as possible for consideration of the Board. Further resolved that as regards to the work completed at Adarshnagar, the Superintendent, Water works is required to put up the report about the total estimated cost of the work, how much work was completed in the year 2010, and to what extent of payment made to the contractor and how much balance work is left etc., in the next board meeting.

PENDING WATER ISSUES WITH HMWS&SB

[05] To consider the matter of the basic Water issues raised by the Cantonment Board Members, Secunderabad are as follows.

- (a) Releasing of Water from Mahindra Hills to Kharkana Reservoir.
- (b) Equate the water tariff to Cantonment Board as per GHMC.
- (c) Arrears pending to HMWS&SB by Cantonment Board, Secunderabad.

All Board Members decided to ensure a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister with assistance of own leaders to resolve the above issues.

Action is pending from Board Members.

RESOLUTION: Matter discussed at length. Shri J. Pratap, Elected Member informed the Board that the Cantonment Board has already submitted all papers to the Government of Andhra Pradesh regarding release of water from Mahendra Hills to Karkhana, about waiving of inter connection charges and also reduction of rates to slums etc. He has further informed that in the meeting chaired by the Chief Minister, Government of Andhra Pradesh on water

related issues. the Cantonment Water Crisis also in figured in the agenda. Further Shri J Pratap and Shri P. Venkat Rao said that they will go the Chief Minister and request him to solve the water problems.
